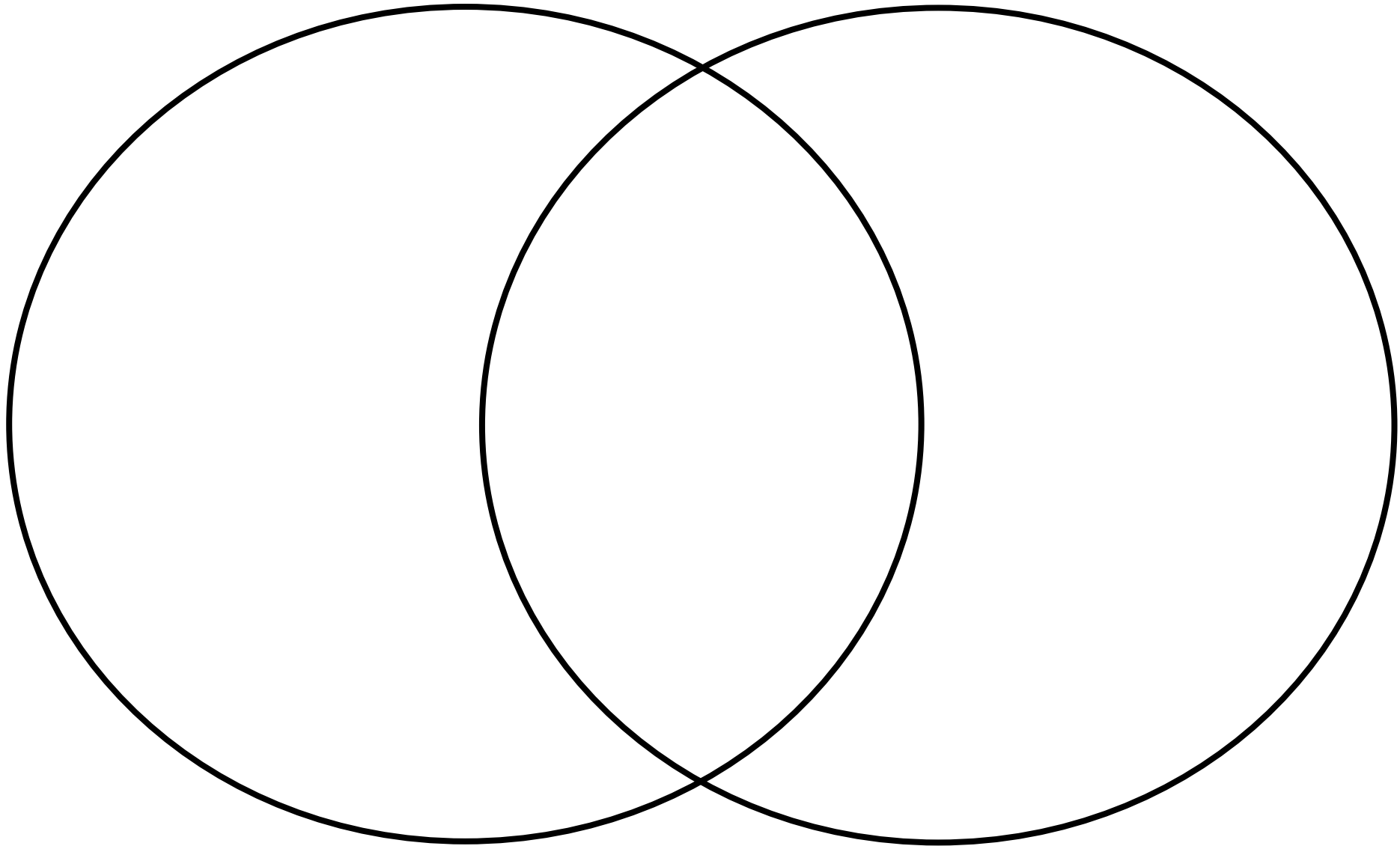
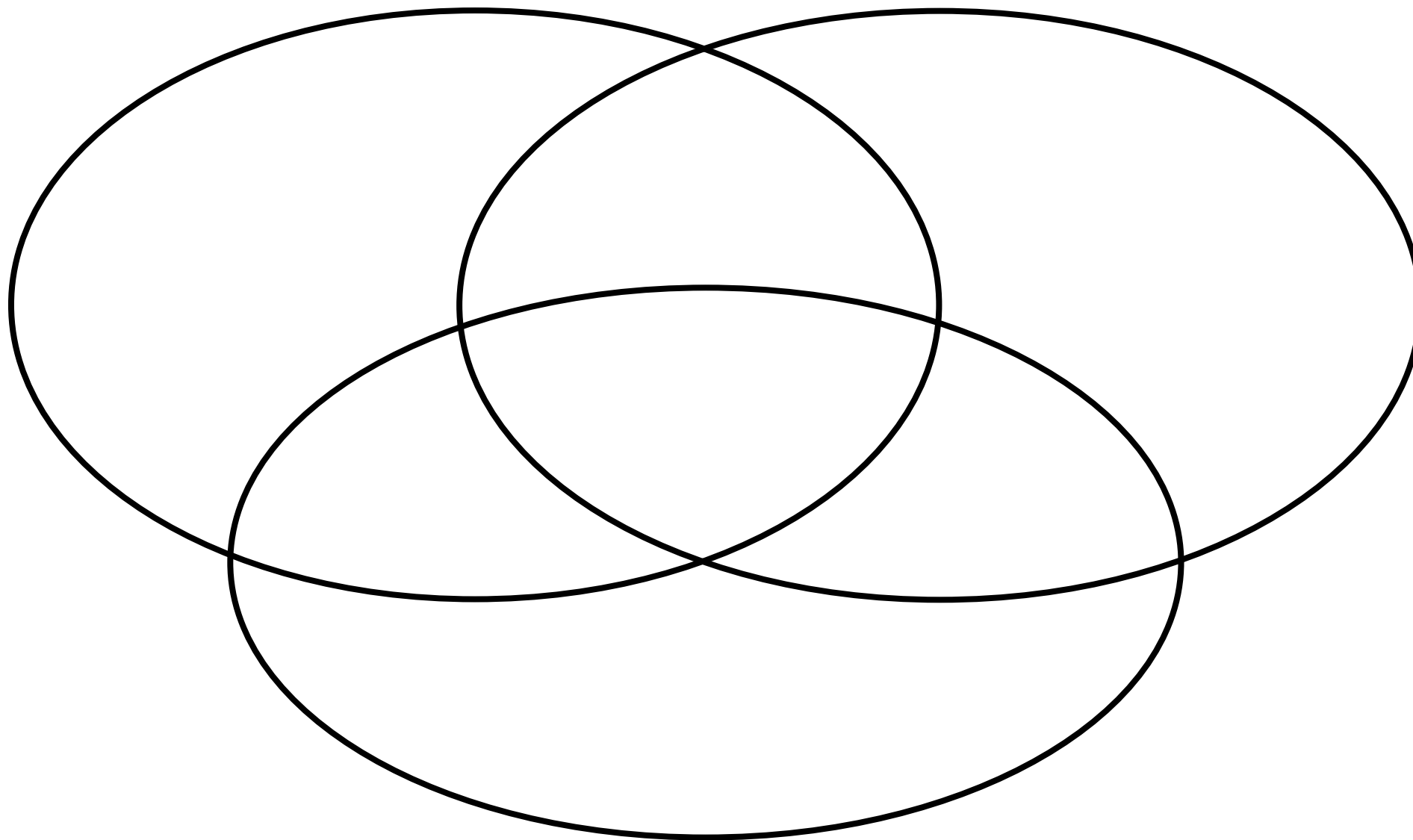


Label the circles with the names of the structures/processes/materials that you are comparing. Write any similarities between the two in the overlap section and any differences in the individual circles.
