Teaching notes

These cards can be used in a variety of ways to practise conversion between metric units:

1. Find as many different ways to make a metre as possible. Record results on paper so you can use values more than once.
2. Using each card only once, find as many different ways to make a metre.
3. What needs to be added to each card in order to make a metre?
4. Convert each card into mm, cm and m.
5. Put all the values in order, smallest to biggest.
6. Create your own length addition questions by shuffling the pack, picking two cards, then adding the values together.
